## BEFORE THE NEVADA STATE BOARD OF 1 MASSAGE THERAPY 2 In the Matter of: ORDER FOR PROBATION Raeann M. Rigirozzi, Licensed Massage Therapist 5 License No. NVMT.10452 6 7 IT APPEARING on June 10, 2020, Raeann M. Rigirozzi ("Rigirozzi") appeared before the 8 Nevada Board of Massage Therapy ("Board") for an application review. 9 The Board granted Rigirozzi a license to practice massage therapy and immediately placed 10 Rigirozzi's license on probation for a period of four (4) years. 11 ORDER 12 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: 13 1. Rigirozzi will attend probation orientation. 2. Rigirozzi shall submit to a background check within one year of the date of this Order, 14 within two years of the date of this Order, within three years of the date of this Order and 15 within four years of the date of this Order at Rigirozzi's expense. 16 3. Rigirozzi must refrain from providing outcall services. 17 4. Rigirozzi must complete an ethics course within 90 calendar days of licensure. 18 5. Rigirozzi must report all contact with law enforcement personnel within forty-eight (48) 19 hours after such contact occurs. 20 6. Rigirozzi must notify the Board of any changes in her employment within 10 calendar 21 days. 22 7. Rigirozzi must provide any changes in address or phone number to the Board office within 10 calendar days. 23 8. Rigirozzi will submit employment offers to the staff of the Board for review and approval. 24 9. Rigirozzi must cooperate fully with the Board staff to administrate terms of her probation. 25 10. Rigirozzi is responsible for all administrative fees incurred by the Board as a result of her 26 probation compliance.

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11. Rigirozzi is to comply with all laws governing massage therapy.

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- 12. This order shall not be construed as excluding or reducing any criminal or civil penalties or sanction or other remedies that may be applicable under federal, state or local laws.
- 13. Rigirozzi's license shall be marked "Restricted" throughout the probationary period.
- 14. Rigirozzi shall meet with the Board or its representatives upon request and shall cooperate with representatives of the Board in her supervision and investigation of Rigirozzi's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Order.
- 15. This Order will become part of Rigirozzi's permanent record, will become public information, will be published with the list of disciplinary actions the Board has taken, and may be reported to any national repository which records disciplinary action taken against licensees or holders of certificates or any agency or another state, which regulates the practice of massage therapy. The Board may use the Order in any subsequent hearings.
- 16. Rigirozzi acknowledges that if she violates one or more of the terms of this Order, the Board may revoke or invoke other appropriate discipline against her license to practice massage therapy; subject only to the requirement that the Board shall, prior to such disciplinary action, conduct a hearing in accordance with Chapters 233B, 622A, and 64°C of the Nevada Revised Statutes for the limited purpose of establishing that there has, in fact, been a violation of the requirements of this Order. In the event that a violation of this Order is alleged, Rigirozzi agrees to surrender her license to the Executive Director, if so requested, and refrain from practicing as a massage therapist until an entry of a final order of the Board or a court of competent jurisdiction, whichever last occurs, regarding the potential violation. Rigirozzi agrees to waive her right to appeal the substantive legal basis of the disciplinary action. In the event an alleged violation of this Order is taken to hearing and the facts which constitute the violation are determined to be not proven, no disciplinary action shall be taken by the Board.
- 17. In the event other misconduct is reported to the Board, this Order may be used as evidence against Rigirozzi to establish a pattern of behavior and for the purpose of proving additional acts of misconduct.
- 18. Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy retains jurisdiction in this case until all conditions have been met to the satisfaction of the Board.

Raeann M. Rigirozzi was present.


Chair Huleva swore in Raeann M. Rigirozzi.

Management Analyst Tereza Van Horn - Ms. Rigirozzi's massage application is before you today due to potential criminal history that could not be approved administratively. Ms. Rigirozzi was arrested on September 28, 1997 by Pueblo Police Department for DUI/DWAI; April 11, 1999 by Pueblo Police Department for Assault; June 13, 2000 by Pueblo Police Department for DUI; May 26, 2011 by Henderson Police Department for Battery/Domestic Violence and April 9, 2015 by Las Vegas Metro Police Department for DUI. Ms. Rigirozzi is requesting to be granted a license under NRS 640C.580 or 420 and is before you today for review under NRS 640C.700. Staff's recommendation is to deny this application or approve a probationary license for four (4) years with restrictions.

Diane Huleva motioned to approve application with a four (4) year probation with the following restrictions: report all contact with law enforcement personnel within forty-

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eight (48) hours after such contact occurs, refrain from providing outcall services, submit employment offers to the staff of the Board for review and approval, notify the Board of any changes in her employment, submit to the Board a complete set of fingerprints each year of renewal at licensees expense, complete an ethics course within ninety (90) calendar days of licensure, attend probation orientation, responsible for all administrative fees incurred by the Board as a result of their probation compliance, notify any change in address or phone number to the Board office within fifteen (15) days, cooperate fully with Board staff to administrate terms of probation and comply with all laws governing massage therapy, seconded by April Whiting. Motion carried unanimously.
