COMPLAINT AND NOTICE OF HEARING

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Respondent.

The Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (Board), by and through its Executive Director, Elisabeth Barnard, hereby notifies Min Ling Huang ("Respondent") of an administrative hearing, which is to be held pursuant to Chapters 233B, 622, 622A of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and 640C of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). The purpose of the hearing is to consider the allegations stated below and to determine if the Respondent should be subject to an administrative penalty as set forth in NRS 640C.710, if the stated allegations are proven at the hearing by the evidence presented.

Respondent is currently and at all times mentioned herein, licensed as a massage therapist in the State of Nevada and is therefore, subject to the jurisdiction of the Board and the provisions of NRS Chapter 640C.

IT IS HEREBY ALLEGED AND CHARGED AS FOLLOWS:

ALLEGED FACTS

- 1. On or about April 30, 2023, Respondent's Massage Therapist license expired.
- 2. On or about May 18, 2023, Board issued Respondent a citation for practicing with an expired license.

3. On or about May 19, 2023, Respondent submitted her online renewal.

- 4. On or about May 22, 2023, Respondent was sent an invoice for the outstanding citation for practicing with an expired license.
- 5. On or about May 24, 2023, the renewal was marked deficient, due to a photo issue. As a result, Respondent's online renewal was not approved.
- 6. On or about May 30, 2023, Respondent re-submitted her renewal.
- 7. On or about May 31, 2023, the renewal was approved.
- 8. On or about June 2, 2023, the license was mailed to Respondent's address on file.
- 9. At all times relevant, Respondent failed to pay her citation for the amount of Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$350.00).

10. On December 11, 2023, Board sent Respondent the past due notice and gave her 15 calendar days to pay her outstanding balance.

11. At the time relevant to this Complaint, Respondent has not made any attempt to communicate with the Board regarding her past due citation.

VIOLATIONS OF LAW

COUNT ONE

12. By failing to pay an administrative fine and comply with the citation, Respondent violated the provisions of NRS 640C.700(16) and/or (17). This is grounds for discipline pursuant to NRS 640C.700(2).

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Executive Director, Elisabeth Barnard, prays as follows:

13. That the Board conduct a hearing on this complaint as provided by statute, and after such hearing, that the Board impose upon Respondent the discipline permitted by NRS 640C.710, which may include the following, (a) the imposition of an administrative fine of not more than \$5,000.00 per violation, (b) recovery of reasonable investigative fees and costs incurred, (c) recovery of attorney fees pursuant to NRS 622.400, (d) licensee be publicly reprimanded, (e) suspend, revoke

1	or place conditions on the licensee's license, (f) place the licensee on probation,	
2	and/or (g) such other impositions as may be permitted by Nevada law.	
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4	PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a disciplinary hearing has been set to consider this	
5	Administrative Complaint against the above-named Respondent in accordance with	
6 7	Chapters 233B, 622, 622A and 640C of the Nevada Revised Statutes. THE HEARING WILL TAKE PLACE on Wednesday, March 20, 2024,	
8	commencing at 9:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the Board is able to hear the matter	
9	with video conferencing by Zoom or by appearing in person.

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You have the right to request that the Board issue subpoenas to compel witnesses to testify and/or evidence to be offered on your behalf. In making this request, you may be required to demonstrate the relevancy of the witnesses' testimony and/or evidence.

The purpose of the hearing is to determine if the Respondent has violated the provisions of Chapter 640C of NRS and if the allegations contained herein are substantially proven by the evidence presented to further determine what administrative penalty is to be assessed against the Respondent, if any, pursuant to NRS 640C.710.

Should the Respondent fail to appear at the hearing, a decision may still be reached by the Board. As the Respondent, you are further advised that you may be charged with the attorney's fees and/or costs associated with the hearing pursuant to NRS 622.400.

Pursuant to NRS 233B.121(5), informal disposition of this case may be made by stipulation, agreed settlement, consent order, or default. Any attempt to negotiate this case should be made by contacting Elisabeth Barnard, (775) 687-9951 or ebarnard@lmt.nv.gov.

Pursuant to NRS 241.033(2)(b), the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy may, without further notice, take administrative action against your license and/or certificate to practice within the State of Nevada if the Board determines that such administrative action is warranted after considering your character, alleged misconduct, professional competence, or physical or mental health.
