### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Ms. Li's massage application is before you today due to potential criminal history that could not be approved administratively. Ms. Li was arrested on January 10, 2017 for prostitution and massage parlor – unlawful conduct by Washington County Sheriff's Office in Utah. Both charges were later dismissed. Ms. Li is requesting to be granted a license under NRS 640C.580 or 420 and is before you today for a review under NRS 640C.700. Staff's recommendation is to deny this application based on NRS 640C.700(1)(4)(6) & (9).

Board Meeting Application review:

Summary of Fengfang Li arrests/charges:

1/10/2017 – Ms. Li was arrested by Washington County Sheriff's office in Utah for prostitution and Massage Parlor - unlawful conduct. According to documents obtained by Washington County Sheriff's office, on 1/10/2017 a search warrant was served at the address of 225 North Bluff St at Dixie Massage in St. George, UT. Fengfang Li was detained and interviewed at the St. George PD using an interpreter. After being informed of her Miranda Rights, Fengfang Li admitted to being employed at Dixie Massage as a massage therapist, performing foot and back massages. She has been employed at this business for about one year. Fengfang Li admitted she is not a licensed massage therapist and does not have a license to work as a massage therapist in the State of Utah. During the interview with Fengfang Li, she admitted to performing a "hand job" act on 2-3 clients. Ms. Li was then arrested for soliciting prostitution; 76-10-1302, and for violation of the Massage Therapy Act; 58-47b-501.

On December 13, 2016 an undercover officer (U/C) entered the business for a massage. At this time Fengfang Li offered to perform sexual acts on the (U/C) in exchange for money.

8/3/2020 - An email to/from Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing indicates Ms. Li is not currently licensed in Utah and has not been disciplined for unlicensed practice.

8/5/2020 – Located a press release online regarding arrests at Dixie Massage.

## Fingerprint Background Waiver

### NOTICE OF NONCRIMINAL JUSTICE APPLICANT'S RIGHTS

As an applicant who is the subject of a Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) fingerprint-based criminal history record check for a noncriminal justice purpose you have certain rights which are discussed below.

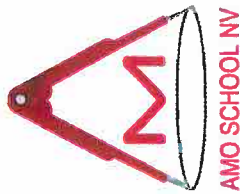

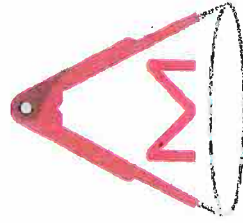



  - . Any government agency or official receiving this order shall not divulge information identifying the petitioner.
  - . Any government agency or official receiving this order shall respond to any inquiry as though the arrest or conviction did not occur.

On January 10th, 2017 the St. George Police Department teamed up with several agencies and served warrants at Dixie Massage located in St. George and Washington City, Japan Massage in St. George, Golden Coast Massage in St. George, and Massage Therapy in St. George as part of an ongoing investigation into Utah business license violations, prostitution and sexual solicitation. As a result of this warrant service, several arrests have been made.

Dixie Massage is located at 225 North Bluff Street in St. George, Utah. During the service of the search warrant Detectives located two females, Feng Fang Li (Suzanne) and [REDACTED] (Jenny.)

Feng Fang Li admitted to being employed at Dixie Massage as a massage therapist for approximately one year. Feng Fang Li admitted she is not a licensed massage therapist and does not have a license to work as a massage therapist in the state of Utah.

Prior to the warrant being served, an undercover officer entered the business for a massage. At this time Feng Fang Li offered to perform sexual acts on the undercover officer in exchange for money. The undercover officer declined. During the course of the interview, Feng admitted to performing sex acts on "2-3 clients."

Feng Fang Li was arrested for 58-47b-301 MASSAGE PARLOR-NO LICENSE a class A Misdemeanor and 76-10-1302 PROSTITUTION a class B Misdemeanor.

After being informed of her Miranda Rights, [REDACTED] admitted to being employed at Dixie Massage as a massage therapist, performing foot and back massages. She has been employed at this business for over a year. [REDACTED] admitted she is not a licensed massage therapist and does not have a license to work as a massage therapist in the state of Utah.

[REDACTED] was arrested for violation of the 58-47b-301 MASSAGE PARLOR-NO LICENSE a class A Misdemeanor.

Dixie Massage is located at 43 N 300 W, Suite A in Washington City. During the warrant service contact was made with [REDACTED]. After being interviewed she was issued a citation for 58-47b-301 MASSAGE PARLOR-NO LICENSE a class A Misdemeanor.

This investigation is still ongoing. Evidence is currently being processed and more charges could be pending.
