ORDER FOR PROBATION

Maurice A. Wilson,
Licensed Massage Therapist
License No. NVMT.10199

IT APPEARING on October 30, 2019, Maurice A. Wilson ("Wilson") appeared before the Nevada Board of Massage Therapy ("Board") for an application review.

The Board granted Wilson a license to practice massage therapy and immediately placed Wilson's license on probation for a period of three (3) years.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Wilson will attend probation orientation.
2. If Wilson is arrested within the three-year probationary period, Wilson must notify the Board within five (5) business days.
3. Wilson's license will be placed on probation for three (3) years from the effective date of this order. For each year of the probation period, Wilson will submit to the Board a complete set of his fingerprints and written permission authorizing the Board to forward the fingerprints to the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History for submission to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for its report. Wilson shall bear the costs associated with the fingerprinting and report.
4. Wilson's employer must provide quarterly reports to Board staff for three years.
5. This order shall not be construed as excluding or reducing any criminal or civil penalties or sanction or other remedies that may be applicable under federal, state or local laws.
6. Wilson's license shall be marked "Restricted" throughout the probationary period.
7. Wilson shall meet with the Board or its representatives upon request and shall cooperate with representatives of the Board in his supervision and investigation of Wilson's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Order.

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- 8. This Order will become part of Wilson's permanent record, will become public information, will be published with the list of disciplinary actions the Board has taken, and may be reported to any national repository which records disciplinary action taken against licensees or holders of certificates or any agency or another state, which regulates the practice of massage therapy. The Board may use the Order in any subsequent hearings.
- 9. Wilson acknowledges that if he violates one or more of the terms of this Order, the Board may revoke or invoke other appropriate discipline against his license to practice massage therapy; subject only to the requirement that the Board shall, prior to such disciplinary action, conduct a hearing in accordance with Chapters 233B, 622A, and 640C of the Nevada Revised Statutes for the limited purpose of establishing that there has, in fact, been a violation of the requirements of this Order. In the event that a violation of this Order is alleged, Wilson agrees to surrender his license to the Executive Director, if so requested, and refrain from practicing as a massage therapist until an entry of a final order of the Board or a court of competent jurisdiction, whichever last occurs, regarding the potential violation. Wilson agrees to waive his right to appeal the substantive legal basis of the disciplinary action. In the event an alleged violation of this Order is taken to hearing and the facts which constitute the violation are determined to be not proven, no disciplinary action shall be taken by the Board.
- 10. In the event other misconduct is reported to the Board, this Order may be used as evidence against Wilson to establish a pattern of behavior and for the purpose of proving additional acts of misconduct.
- 11. Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy retains jurisdiction in this case until all conditions have been met to the satisfaction of the Board.
