IT APPEARING on March 27, 2019, Tiavera Robinson ("Robinson") appeared before the Nevada Board of Massage Therapy ("Board") for an application review.

The Board granted Robinson a license to practice massage therapy and immediately placed Robinson's license on probation for a period of five (5) years.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Robinson will attend probation orientation.
2. Robinson shall submit to a background check annually at Robinson's expense.
3. Robinson must refrain from outcall service.
4. Robinson's employer must provide monthly reports to Board staff.
5. If Robinson is arrested for solicitation of prostitution within the five year probationary period, Robinson's license will be immediately revoked for ten years.
6. This order shall not be construed as excluding or reducing any criminal or civil penalties or sanction or other remedies that may be applicable under federal, state or local laws.
7. Robinson's license shall be marked "Restricted" throughout the probationary period.
8. Robinson shall meet with the Board or its representatives upon request and shall cooperate with representatives of the Board in her supervision and investigation of Robinson's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Order.
9. This Order will become part of Robinson's permanent record, will become public information, will be published with the list of disciplinary actions the Board has taken, and may be reported to any national repository which records disciplinary action taken against licensees or holders of certificates or any agency or another state, which regulates the practice of massage therapy. The Board may use the Order in any subsequent hearings.

3 11. Robinson acknowledges that if she violates one or more of the terms of this Order, the
4 Board may revoke or invoke other appropriate discipline against her license to practice
5 massage therapy; subject only to the requirement that the Board shall, prior to such
6 disciplinary action, conduct a hearing in accordance with Chapters 233B, 622A, and 640C
7 of the Nevada Revised Statutes for the limited purpose of establishing that there has, in
8 fact, been a violation of the requirements of this Order. In the event that a violation of this
9 Order is alleged, Robinson agrees to surrender her license to the Executive Director, if so
10 requested, and refrain from practicing as a massage therapist until an entry of a final order
11 of the Board or a court of competent jurisdiction, whichever last occurs, regarding the
12 potential violation. Robinson agrees to waive her right to appeal the substantive legal
13 basis of the disciplinary action. In the event an alleged violation of this Order is taken to
14 hearing and the facts which constitute the violation are determined to be not proven, no
15 disciplinary action shall be taken by the Board.


16 12. In the event other misconduct is reported to the Board, this Order may be used as evidence
17 against Robinson to establish a pattern of behavior and for the purpose of proving
18 additional acts of misconduct.

19 13. Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy retains jurisdiction in this case until all conditions
20 have been met to the satisfaction of the Board.

Ms. Robinson:

After a review of your application by the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (Board), the Board approved a probationary license for five (5) years with the following conditions:
