BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Ms. Geng's reflexology application is before you today for review that could not be approved administratively. Ms. Geng was arrested on August 21, 2004 for unauthorized practice of profession and/or unauthorized practice of profession title and arrested on November 20, 2004 for prostitution by New York City Police Department (NYCPD). Records request sent to New York provided no details surrounding previous arrests or violations. Ms. Geng has been cited by NSBMT on three separate occasion. Two violations for practicing without having a license and the third recently for sanitation violations. Ms. Geng is requesting to be granted a license under NRS 640C.580 and is before you today for review under NRS 640C.700.

Board Meeting Application review:

Summary of Yuqin Geng arrests/charges:

7/26/2021 – Cited by NSBMT for sanitation violations. A citation for \$800.00 plus \$150.00 admin fees was issued to Ms. Geng. At this time of this report, the fines have not been paid.

12/2/2015 - Cited by NSBMT for practicing without having a license. Was given a fine of \$550.00 with admin fee of \$150.00. Ms. Geng paid citation on 12/23/2015.

7/31/2012 - Cited by NSBMT for practicing without having a license. Was given a fine of \$350.00 with admin fee of \$150.00. Ms. Geng was also given a citation as the business owner/manager for #1 Foot Reflexology in the amount of \$350.00 plus admin fee of \$150.0. Ms. Geng appealed the citations and was scheduled to appear on November 2, 2012. According to Board minutes, the Board dismissed the citation that was given to Ms. Geng. No record of payment being received from business. No outstanding citation for #1 Foot Reflexology.

7/11/2012 – Applicant supplied US Dept. of Justice immigration review, Immigration court documents to NSBMT for additional information. In those documents on page 2, middle paragraph, it indicates Ms. Geng was convicted of prostitution the paragraph further reads that she entered a guilty plea and was given a condition discharge of 1 year plus 2 days of community service. In addition, she was convicted on December 15, 2004 of prostitution and entered a guilty plea to the chare and that she was given a conditional discharge of 1 year, plus 5 days of community service. Finally, Ms. Geng was convicted on July 12, 2005 for disorderly conduct in violation of section 240.20. Ms. Geng entered a guilty plea to the charge and was given a condition discharge of one year.

* Online review of 240.20 reads "A person **is guilty of disorderly conduct** when, with intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance or alarm, or recklessly creating a risk thereof: He engages in fighting or in violent, tumultuous or threatening behavior; or. He makes unreasonable noise; or.

11/20/2004 – Prostitution by New York City Police Department (NYCPD).

Per statement from applicant, she was practicing in a foot/massage spa as a foot massage worker. She did not produce evidence of a license, and she was cited.

8/21/2004 – Unauthorized practice of profession and/or unauthorized use of professional title by New York City Police Department (NYCPD).

Per statement from applicant, the officer made a mistake or on purpose to charge for prostitution when it should have been unauthorized practice of profession. Her and 4 other employees were cited and given citations. Disposition on background indicates a guilty plea was entered and she was given community service of 5 day(s) to discharge/dismiss case.

DECISION AND ORDERS OF THE IMMIGRATION JUDGE

I. Procedural History

The respondent is a 46-year-old married female who is a native and citizen of the People's Republic of China ("PRC"). She was admitted to the United States at New York, New York on or about July 23, 2000, as a non-immigrant B-1 visitor for business, with permission to remain for 90 days. The respondent did not depart the United States.

The record reflects that the respondent married a United States citizen on March 31, 2008. Her spouse filed a Form I-130 on her behalf, and the petition was approved on May 28, 2009. The respondent subsequently filed a Form I-485, application for adjustment of status, with the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services ("USCIS"). The USCIS denied the respondent's application, and referred her case to the Immigration Court, by means of a Notice to Appear dated August 31, 2010. See Exhibit 1.



The respondent has conceded that she is subject to **removal** as a nonimmigrant overstay. However, she sought to renew her application for adjustment in Court, along with an application for a section 212(h) waiver. See Exhibit 2. A hearing on the merits of these applications was conducted on July 10, 2012. The respondent was the primary witness in support of the application. Her United States citizen spouse also appeared to testify on her behalf, as well as her lawful permanent resident sister.

II. Lawand Analysis

As noted above, the respondent does have an approved, immediate relative visa petition, which makes her eligible for adjustment of status in accordance with section 245(a)(3) of the Act. However, as an applicant for adjustment of status, the respondent has the burden of proving that she is "admissible to the United States for permanent residence." See section 245(a)(2) of the Act. Because the respondent was convicted of several offenses relating to prostitution in New York in 2004, she submitted a section 212(h) waiver, in order to overcome her apparent inadmissibility under section 212(a)(2)(D) of the Act.

The respondent was convicted, on August 22, 2004, in the Criminal Court of the City of New York, County of New York, of loitering for the purpose of engaging in a prostitution offense, in violation of section 240.37 of the New York Penal Law. The respondent's certificate of disposition reflects that she entered a guilty plea to the charge, and that she was given a conditional discharge of 1 year, plus 2 days of community service. The respondent was also convicted, on December 15, 2004, in the Criminal Court of the City of New York, County of Queens, of prostitution in violation of section 230 of the New York Penal Law.¹ The respondent's certificate of disposition reflects that she entered a guilty plea to the charge, and that she was given a conditional discharge of 1 year, plus 5 days of community service. Finally, the respondent was convicted, on July 12, 2005, in the Criminal Court of the City of New York, County of Queens, of disorderly conduct in violation of section 240.20 of the New York Penal Law. The respondent's certificate of disposition reflects that she entered a guilty plea to the New York, County of New York, County of Queens, of disorderly conduct in violation of section 240.20 of the New York Penal Law. The respondent's certificate of disposition reflects that she entered a guilty plea to the charge, and that she was given a conditional discharge of 1 year.

Because the respondent pled guilty to two charges specifically relating to prostitution, the Court concludes that she is inadmissible under section 212(a)(2)(D)(i) of the Act. See Matter of Gonzalez-Zoquiapan, 24 I&N Dec. 549, 553 (BIA 2008); see also Kepelino v. Gonzales, 454 F.3d 1057, 1061 (9th Cir. 2006). Pursuant to section 212(h)(1)(A)(i) of the Act, however, the respondent can establish eligibility for this waiver if she is "only" inadmissible as a result of the offenses relating to prostitution.² Accordingly, the Court need not address the issue of whether

²The Court notes that the respondent arguably is also inadmissible under section 212(a)(2)(A)(i)(I) of the Act, because the prostitution offenses may also constitute crimes involving moral turpitude (CIMTs). However, there will invariably be an overlap between the

the denial of her application for adjustment of status would cause "extreme hardship" to her United States citizen spouse, because the respondent has demonstrated eligibility under the first prong of the 212(h) waiver. The Court is also satisfied that the respondent has established rehabilitation, and that her admission to the United States would not be contrary to the safety or security of this country. See sections 212(h)(1)(A)(ii) and (iii) of the Act.

Because the respondent has shown statutory eligibility for relief under sections 245(a) and 212(h) of the Act, the remaining issue is whether she warrants relief in the exercise of discretion. In Matter of Arai, 13 I&N Dec. 494, 496 (BIA 1970), the Board stated that an adjustment of status applicant with adverse factors in his or her record may have to demonstrate "unusual or even outstanding equities" to warrant this discretionary relief. The respondent here was convicted of the above-mentioned misdemeanor offenses in 2004 and 2005. There is no indication in the record that she has subsequently engaged in any criminal activity. The Court therefore considers the respondent's evidence of rehabilitation as a positive factor in her application. The respondent has now lived in the United States for 12 years, and has family ties to this country consisting of a United States citizen spouse, lawful permanent resident sister, and lawful permanent resident daughter who recently immigrated to the United States based upon the respondent's husband's petition. Accordingly, the Court will conclude that the respondent's equities offset her adverse factors, and the application for adjustment of status will be approved in the exercise of discretion.

Based on the foregoing, the Court will enter the following orders:

<u>ORDERS</u>

IT IS ORDERED that the respondent's application for adjustment of status be GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the instant removal proceedings be terminated.

On Tuesday, July 26, 2021 I entered the business of #1 Foot Reflexology to conduct a second follow-up inspection. The manager, Yuqin Geng was behind the reception desk. I identified myself and stated I was there for the second follow-up inspection. There was one licensed employee identified as Yuan Ren NVMR.0110 also in the establishment.

I was conducting this second follow-up sanitation inspection because I had visited this establishment on April 26, 2021 and it was closed. I returned on April 29th and conducted the first sanitation inspection which was non-compliant. I returned on May 18, 2021 to conduct the follow-up inspection which resulted in non-compliance. I returned to the establishment on July 26, 2021 for the second follow-up inspection. Once again, this inspection was non-compliant. The floors continued to be dirty and have hair on them. The rooms with soft tables were dirty and while I was inspecting the two women were putting plastic shower curtains over the tables. The lighting in the room identified as room 3 still had inadequate minimum lighting and measured at 4.62-foot candle which is close to the required 5.0 foot candle. I had suggested many times to replace the bulb with a new higher watt bulb to fix that room and Yuqin Geng acknowledged she would correct it immediately. She did not.

The lotion bottles were still dirty, especially around the pump area. Yuqin Geng had indicated to me on my visits that she is only the manager. She is still pending board review for a massage application.

I issued an administrative citation for NAC 640C.200 (3) (c): tables (not clean), NAC 640C.210: Lubricants-Rm 2, NAC 640C.220: Structure-Rm 2 (this is for the dirty floor); NAC 640C230 (1)(d) Room (this is for the lighting). Each of these violations for a first offense is \$200.00 each X 4 plus \$150.00 administrative fee for a total of \$950.00.

I explained again to Yuqin Geng the necessity for cleaning and disinfecting regularly and often, especially with Covid-19 and the deviant virus in the State of Nevada getting higher.
