BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Ms. Kelly's massage application is before you today due to potential criminal history that could not be approved administratively. Ms. Kelly was arrested or cited (e-ticket) for Prostitution June 16, 2017 by Renton Special Enforcement Team. The Renton Special Enforcement Team conducted an investigation into a rubmaps.com advertisement regarding Celebrity Spa. Ms. Kelly was before the Board on June 10, 2020 and her application was denied. Her Attorney Lyn Beggs requested a reconsider on October 16, 2020. The Board approved to reconsider the application on January 20, 2021. Ms. Kelly is requesting to be granted a license under NRS 640C.580 or 420 and is before you today for review under NRS 640C.700. Staff's recommendation is to deny this application based on NRS.640C.700(2)(3)(4)(6) and (9).

Board Meeting Application review:

Summary of Lianyan Kelly arrests/charges:

06/16/2017 – Ms. Kelly was arrested or cited by Renton Special Enforcement Team for one count of prostitution. According to documents received by Renton PD, an investigation was conducted on April 7, 2017 on rubmaps.com. Celebrity Spa at 20 SW 7th St. Ste G. Celebrity Spa had four out of five reviews in the previous six months which stated an employee of celebrity spa provided sexual service, in these instances manual stimulation of the penis, commonly referred to as a "hand job" for an additional fee.

On 4/12/2017 – an undercover officer entered Celebrity Spa at the aforementioned address. In the large window adjacent to the entry door was an illuminated neon sign which read, "open." Additionally, above the signage "Celebrity Spa" on the building was another sign reading "massage 347-885-xxxx." Undercover obtained a half an hour massage from an Asian female who identified herself as Andrea. Undercover did not observe a massage practitioner license for Andrea conspicuously or otherwise displayed inside the business.

Prior to the massage, he paid Andrea \$40.00 from the undercover funds. Cash was previously photographed, and the serial numbers recorded. He also confirmed, based on her age, Andrea was not the listed owner of the business.

Andrea instructed undercover to take off his clothing; he did so and positioned himself stomach down on the massage table. He left his boxers on. Andrea massage undercovers upper back and then slid her hands underneath his boxers touching his buttocks. Undercover asked her if she wanted him to remove his boxers. She states, "only if you want to" to which he responded, "if you want to you can do it." Andrea continued the massage but again slid her hands underneath his boxers touching his buttocks. She then walked to the foot of the table and removed undercovers boxers leaving his naked. She then massaged his buttocks for several minutes and then grazed his testicles with her hands several times.

She then asked undercover to turn over and continued to massage his chest while he lay there naked. After a few minutes, undercover grabbed a small towel to cover his genitals. Andrea pointed to the undercover's jeans, which were draped on a chair and gestured for money. He asked her how much and made the common gesture for "hand job." Andrea replied by telling him not to talk and then holding up six fingers and then made a zero with her fingers indicating \$60.00. He told her he needed to get cash but would come back later.

She promptly finished the massage and the undercover left after assuring her he would be back with \$100.00 to which she responded with a change of demeanor and gave him a hug.

Undercover provided a written statement, which was submitted into evidence and available to the prosecutor and/or defense upon request.

Based on undercovers account, I completed a warrant to search the business known as Celebrity Spa for evidence of the violation of Prostitution.

On 4/13/2017 – A warrant was served at Celebrity Spa. Officers knocked and announced the presence of police and our intention to serve the warrant. We also directed all occupants of the building to come outside. After three loud and clear announcements, we started our search of the business. As we

proceeded down the hall, a young Asian female exited from a room and was detained without incident. She was later identified with her Chinese passport and us Permanent resident card as xxxxxx Li. Inside the room which Li emerged was an Asian male, lying face down, naked on a massage table. He was barely covered by a small towel. He was identified as Alex XX with his WADL. Alex was allowed to dress and detained without incident.

We continued to announce our presence as we walked down the hall. In the next room, another Asian female waked out of the room and into the hallway. Undercover officer positively identified her as "Andrea" from whom he received an offer and agreement for sexual contact for money the previous day. "Andrea" was later positively identified from her WADL as Lianyan Kelly. She was detained without incident. In the room from which Kelly emerged was a white male, lying naked face down on the massage table. He was partially covered with a small towel over his buttocks. He was later positively identified via his WADL as Jay XXXXXXX.

There was no one else located inside the business. In the front room a Renton Business License and a State of Washington Business license were prominently displayed. In the rear breakroom officers located identification for both Li and Kelly. A total of \$1,550.00 of US currency was in Li and Kelly's purses. A ledger was also located which appeared to tally how much each made per day. Inside Kelly's purse a Massage Practitioners license (MA 60705117) was located.

Written statements were obtained from both Jay and Alex. Both admitted, albeit reluctantly, they were there to obtain manual stimulation of the penis, thou had not obtained such at the time of the warrant service.

Kelly has worked for Celebrity Spa for two weeks. She received 50% of the massage fee plus tips because she has a massage license. She gives Li the spa proceeds at the end of the day and Li gives them to the owner. Kelly did not know the owner's name but refers to her as "little Dragon." She obtained the job from an online Chinese advertisement.

As Celebrity Spa was not operating in compliance with Renton Municipal Code or the Revised Code of Washington, both Li and Kelly were advised, if they continued working there, they would be subject to arrest. Li was provided a warning for providing massage without a license.

Ms. Kelly was cited via complaint with reference 7Z0619984 for prostitution. Ms. Kelly did commit prostitution by offering or agree to sexual conduct, manual stimulation of the penis, for a fee, of \$60.00.

NOTICE OF NONCRIMINAL JUSTICE APPLICANT'S RIGHTS

As an applicant who is the subject of a Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) (Ingerprint-based criminal history record check for a noncriminal justice purpose you have certain rights which are discussed below.

- 1. You must be notified by the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy that your fingerprints will be used to check the criminal history records of the FBI and the State of Nevada.
- 2. If you have a criminal history record, the officials making a determination of your suitability for the job, license or other benefit for which you are applying must provide you the opportunity to complete or challenge the accuracy of the information in the record. You may review and challenge the accuracy of any and all criminal history records which are returned to the submitting agency. The proper forms and procedures will be furnished to you by the Nevada Department of Public Safety, Records Bureau upon request. If you decide to challenge the accuracy or completeness of you FBI criminal history record, Title 28 of the Code of Federal Regulations Section 16.34 provides for the proper procedure to do so:

16.34 - Procedure to obtain change, correction or updating of identification records. If, after reviewing his/her identification record, the subject thereof believes that it is incorrect or incomplete in any respect and wishes changes, corrections or updating of the alleged deficiency, he/she should make spplication directly to the agency which contributed the questioned information. Dear Ms. Anderson:

I represent Lianyan Kelly, whose application for a license to practice massage therapy in the state of Nevada was recently denied by the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy ("Board") on June 10, 2020. This letter shall serve as the formal request for reconsideration of Ms. Kelly's application which was originally submitted to the Board on October 28, 2019. Ms. Kelly is submitting this request as upon review of the application and supporting documentation and review of the recording of the Board meeting held on June 10th, it appears that the Board may in part have based the decision to deny the application based on erroneous information.

There are two specific issues that we believe were not accurately conveyed during the course of the Board meeting conducted on June 10, 2020; first, Ms. Kelly's criminal history, or lack thereof, and second, the alleged failure of Ms. Kelly to notify the state of Washington, where she holds a license to practice massage therapy, of an alleged arrest.

As properly disclosed by Ms. Kelly in her 2018 application, in April 2017, she was working as a massage therapist at a spa in Renton, Washington. Approximately a little over a week after Ms. Kelly began working at the spa, detectives from the Renton Police Department served a warrant on the spa while Ms. Kelly was present. Ms. Kelly was not arrested or charged with any offense at the time. Three months later, in June 2017, Ms. Kelly received by mail a citation from the Renton Municipal Court charging her with misdemeanor prostitution. It must be stressed that a citation is a charging document, it is not evidence of a conviction. An individual cited for a misdemeanor is entitled to due process regarding the charge before a finding of guilty may be made.

In the matter described above, Ms. Kelly, who was represented by criminal defense counsel, pleaded not guilty to the charge of prostitution. Per an agreement with the prosecutor, if Ms. Kelly were to complete certain conditions, it was agreed that the charges would be dismissed. Upon discussion with her attorney, Ms. Kelly agreed to complete the requested conditions and the parties signed a Stipulated Order of Continuance. Ms. Kelly completed all conditions of the Stipulation and all charges were dismissed on November 29, 2018. (See Exhibit A). Ms. Kelly maintained her innocence at all times throughout the proceedings and at no time pleaded guilty, nor was any finding of guilty made against her. No conviction was ever entered against Ms. Kelly.

During the review of Ms. Kelly's application by the Board at the June 10, 2020 meeting, concerns were raised about Ms. Kelly failing to notify the state of Washington about the citation. It was conveyed to the Board that Ms. Kelly had an affirmative duty to report the citation to Washington; this is incorrect. Revised Code of Washington (RCW) section 18.130.070(4)(a)(i) requires a licensee to report "any conviction, determination, or finding that he or she has committed unprofessional conduct or is unable to practice with reasonable skill or safety". Washington law does not require a licensee to report a citation for a misdemeanor, nor an arrest. We wish to emphasize that there was no arrest in this matter; Ms. Kelly was simply sent the citation notifying her of the misdemeanor charge.

Based on the denial of Ms. Kelly's application by the Board, the Massage Therapy Program of the Washington Board of Health ("BOH") (the licensing entity for the profession in Washington) notified Ms. Kelly on August 14, 2020 that it was opening an investigation into the matter. (See Exhibit B). On September 10, 2020, the BOH notified Ms. Kelly that the matter was being closed without disciplinary action as "the evidence does not support a violation". (See Exhibit C).

Ms. Kelly does not believe that the Board had accurate information regarding her lack of criminal history nor the fact that she did not have a duty to report the citation to the state of Washington. Ms. Kelly therefore respectfully submits this request for reconsideration of her application at the next scheduled meeting of the Board to further discuss this matter. Please be advised that I will appear with Ms. Kelly at any future appearance before the Board.

We appreciate the Board's consideration of this request and should the Board require any additional information regarding this matter, please do not hesitate to contact me.
