BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Ms. He's massage application is before you today due to potential criminal history that could not be approved administratively. Ms. He was previously licensed with NSBMT with a probationary license on October 12, 2007. Probation termination was granted on 10/23/2009. Ms. He was arrested on 12/28/06 for solicitation of prostitution, 1/7/2007 for solicitation of prostitution, 10/08/2009 for false information to a police officer and 10/22/2010 for solicitation of prostitution by Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department. Ms. He had her NCBTMB national exam results revoked on 8/25/2011. Ms. He is requesting to be granted a license under NRS 640C.580 or 420 and is before you today for review under NRS 640C.700. Staff's recommendation is to deny this application based on NRS.640C.700(2)(3)(4)(6) and (9).

Board Meeting Application review:

Summary of Ping He arrests/charges:

12/28/2006 – Detective XXX was working undercover operations investigating prostitution at Paradise Spa at 2120 S. Paradise in Las Vegas, NV.

I entered the establishment on the terms of getting a massage. I spoke with a female who stated it would be \$70.00 for a half hour body massage. Then paid the female, later identified as He, Ping, the \$80.00 at which time she reimbursed me \$10.00 in change. We then entered into one of the massage rooms where she began to perform a therapeutic massage. At the conclusion of the massage she asked if I was happy and if I liked the massage. I stated the massage was okay. She asked I wanted anything else and pointed towards my genital areas (referring to my penis). She stated, "Do you want more?" I stated, "For how much?" As she was doing the hand motion referring to oral masturbation, I stated, "forty dollars?" She said, "A little bit more." I then stated, "sixty?" She then gave me a finger sign number one. I stated, "one hundred?" She nodded and said, "yes" at the same time. I then got up from the table reached into my pocket and grabbed a hundred-dollar bill out, at which time I then handed it to her, and she placed it in her pocket. During the first part of the massage, I did speak with the female in casual conversation and asked her where she was from, how long she'd been here, and she spoke english back to me. Detectives entered the establishment, and Ms. He was placed into custody and placed under arrest for soliciting prostitution.

1/7/2007 — Detective XX working undercover operations investigating prostitution at Paradise Spa at 2120 S. Paradise in Las Vegas, NV.

While working as an undercover vice detective I went into an Asian establishment. When I entered, an Asian female asked me do you want a massage. I said, "yes, that what I's m here for." She then directed me to a room where I saw many different other rooms with massage tables and towels. I went into one of the rooms and this Asian female told me to take off all my clothes and lay down on the table. After I undressed and laid on the table, the woman later identified as He, Ping entered the room and with oil began to massage my back, buttocks and legs. After doing this for a short period, she told me to turn over. I then laid on my back. She then began to massage my upper body and legs and then moved over towards my genitals and started to massage there. She then said, "you're not the police, are you? You're a big strong guy, you're strong like policeman." I said, "no, I'm not the police." She said, "Can I see your ID?" I then showed her an identification card and then she looked at it and then said, "okay, lay back down." She then began to massage me again and then began to touch my genital. She then said, "you sure you're not the police?" I said, "No, I'm not the police." She said, "Well, let's go in the shower, will give me some tips?" I then said, "Yeah, how much and I going to need?" She said, "We can't talk about it right here." I then put my right fist in a cupping motion and did in a masturbation symbol and I said, "Can you hook me up? Maybe give me a blow job?" She then nodded her head in a yes motion and said that I can't talk about that right here. We'll talk about it when we're in the shower. I said, "How much money am I going to need?" She said, I can't talk about money, I don't want to get in trouble." She then said, "Just take your wallet and we'll go in the shower." I then identified myself as an undercover vice detective while other detectives were entering the establishment. Ms. He was placed under arrest for soliciting for the purpose of prostitution.

10/08/2009 – Detective XXX along with other detectives of vice were conducting an in-call massage parlor investigation at the Hongye Massage & Spa located at 3385 S. Decatur.

I entered the Hongye Massage & Spa posing as a customer, and contacted an Asian female who charged me \$50.00 for a massage, and then escorted me to a back room, and instructed me to take off my clothes and lay on the massage table with a towel over me. At that time, she exited the room, and a few minutes later another Asian female who would late be identified as He, Ping, would enter the room to conduct the massage. During the massage it was clear that He, Ping had seemed to have very little experience conducting the massage, and she had a limited amount of skill.

During the massage He, Ping would expose me several times, but did not offer to manipulate my genitals or solicit me for prostitution in any way. At the conclusion of the massage He, Ping instructed me to get dressed, and told me that the massage was over. At that time, I gave a prearranged signal to surveilling team who entered the business along with

detectives from vice to conduct a site check for the business, and assure that all proper licensing of the massage parlor, and for the massage therapists were present.

While attempting to identify the Asian female who conducted the massage on me, she gave an ID and a State of Nevada massage license ID in the name of QXXX XXXX Qiu. It should be noted that the detectives that the detectives conducting the site check were wearing department issued yellow raid jackets which are clearly marked police and LVMPD.

He, Ping was told several times that the license appeared fake, and that the license said foot handler on it, and it did not look like her. She was warned that if she continued to lie about who she is, she would be arrested for false information to a police officer.

It should be noted that during the massage He, Ping spoke clear and intelligible English to me and understood everything I was saying to her in English. He, Ping began to say that she did not speak English, but she did speak Cantonese. After several warning, Ms. He finally identified herself as He, Ping by her actual massage license which was a restricted license requiring supervisor to be present.

Due to the fact she had been warned several times and that she still lied to uniform police officers about her identification, and had passed a false information/identification as her ID, He, Ping was cited for False information to a police officer.

10/22/2010 – Ms. He was arrested by LVMPD for solicitation of prostitution.

Detective S. XXXX was working n an undercover capacity at 3385 S. Decatur, Ste 32, which is the Hong Ye Massage parlor. I was working in an undercover capacity investigating vice-related crimes. I proceeded to go into the business when an unknown Asian female, later identified as He, greeted me at the door. She then walked me back to massage room #3, and then asked me how long of a massage I would like. I stated I would like a half-hour massage. Shen then stated that was \$50.00. I then proceeded to give her a \$100.00 bill of LVMPD marked money, and in return, she left the room and instructed me get undressed and lay on the table.

She then returned approximately a couple of minutes later, and handed me \$50.00 change, and put it on the table, and stated, here is my change for the \$100.00. At which time, she proceeded to give me a massage, where I was covered by a towel that was provided. The whole entire time I had the towel on me when she gave me the massage. At which time I was laying on my stomach, when she pulled down the towel exposing my butt. She came in and out of the room a few times, and when she came back in the last time, she told me to turn over. When I turned over, I placed the towel, again covering my genital area, when she continued to give me the massage. At which time, she removed the towel exposing my genitals. When I sat up and asked her if I could get anything else as I recovered my genitals with my towel, she said, Oh, my back is soar, you rub my back. I said well, why don't you get nude on the table, and I'll rub you down. She then laughed and said, no, just rub my back if you would please, my back hurts.

At that time, I proceed to rub her back for one second, and asked her, is there anything else I can get? She said, yeah, how much? I said, I'll give you the \$50.00 change, she said no. I said, you want \$100.00? She said, yeah. I said, \$100.00 just for a hand job? She said, yes, but I'll take it nice and slow, make it really nice for you. I then asked her, well, can I get a blowjob? Or can I Fuck you? She said, No I only do that. I said, what just a handjob? She said, yeah, massage you nicely. I said, for \$100.00, why don't you take off your clothes, that way I can look at you while you're doing it. He then told me, I don't take off my clothes, but you can touch and rub all over me.

At that time, I gave a predetermines bust signal when assisting LVMPD came inside the business. At which time, He walked out of my room, closing the door behind. I proceeded to get dressed when I came out to meet the LVMPD. He was then placed under arrest for soliciting prostitution, due to the fact she willfully and unlawfully agreed to give me manual masturbation until completion for a fee of \$100.00.

Billie Shea advised Ms. Greco that the Board has a long day ahead of them and appreciates her passion, but the Board has other people that still need to come before them.

Ms. Greco stated that if the Board wants to make what the motion would be, and if it is to terminate Ms. He's probation, then Ms. Greco will abstain from any argument at all. If it is not going to be, then Ms. Greco will reserve her right to argue on it. Ms. Greco stated that she brought a witness as well.

Lisa Cooper stated that Ms. He is before the Board requesting termination of her probation. Ms. He was placed on a two year probation on October 18, 2007. 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ORDER OF PROBATION

The following is the order in the case involving Ping He (Respondent) by the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapists. (Board)

ORDER

It is hereby ordered that Nevada Licensed Massage Therapists License No. NVMT.3073, issued in the name of Ping He is placed on probation (restricted Licensure) for a minimum of two (2) years with the following terms and conditions:

- If, after notice and hearing, Respondent is found to have violated any of the following terms and conditions, the Board may revoke probation for Respondent and carry out any appropriate disciplinary action pursuant to NRS 640C.710. The Board shall have continuing jurisdiction over any complaint filed against Respondent to revoke probation until such matter is final.
- This order shall not be construed as excluding or reducing any criminal or civil penalties or sanction or other remedies that may be applicable under federal, state or local laws.

PROBATION CONDITIONS

- Respondent must report all contact with law enforcement within 48 hours to The Board.
- 2. Respondent may not provide outcall service.
- 3. Respondent must approve employment with The Board.
- 4. Respondent must notify The Board of any change in employment within 24 hours
- 5. Respondent must complete 6 hours of ethics education within 90 days

- Respondent must submitted 2 finger print card with renewal for period of two years. with administrative fee of \$100.00
- 7. Respondent must have adequate supervision while at work: Supervisor must be approved by The Board prior to taking employment.
- 8. Respondent must notify any Change in address to The Board office within 15 days.
- 9. Respondent must report any inappropriate behavior from a client during a massage to The Board within 24 hours.
- 10. Respondent must submit to a FBI/Local fingerprint background check.

7. LICENSE MARKED "RESTRICTED"

. . .

RESPONDENT shall, have her license marked "Restricted" throughout the probationary period.

8. TIME EARNED OFF PROBATION

RESPONDENT shall only receive credit toward service of her probation period while employed in a capacity for which a Massage Therapist is required and subject to adequate supervision approved by the Board

9. WRITTEN NOTIFICATION OF TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT TO BOARD

RESPONDENT is required to notify the Board in writing within seventy-two (72) hours after commencement or termination of any Massage Therapists employment, as that license is now void and must be reissued with new supervisor. Any notification regarding termination shall contain a full explanation of the circumstances surrounding it.

10. SUBMISSION OF ORDER TO IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR

RESPONDENT shall provide a copy of this Order to her employer and immediate supervisor.

11. REQUIREMENT TO MEET WITH THE BOARD OR STAFF UPON REQUEST

RESPONDENT shall meet with the Board or its representatives upon request and shall cooperate with representatives of the Board in their supervision and investigation of Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Order.

12. TERMINATION OF PROBATION

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Upon completion of the requirements of this Order, Respondent shall apply for termination of probation on forms supplied by the Board. Respondent shall meet with The Board's Executive Director regarding a probation period. The probation shall continue until terminated by the Board. The Board will determine whether or not probation will be terminated.

13. REPORTING TO NATIONAL DISCIPLINARY DATA BANKS

This Order will become part of the Respondent's permanent record, will become public information, will be published with the list of disciplinary actions the Board has taken, and may be reported to any national repository which records disciplinary action taken against licensees or holders of certificates; or any agency or another state, which regulates the practice of Massage Therapy. The Board may use the Order in any subsequent hearings.

14. CONSEQUENCES OF FURTHER VIOLATIONS INCLUDING VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDER; ORDER TO SURRENDER LICENSE

RESPONDENT acknowledges that if she should violate one or more of the terms of this Order, the Board may revoke, or invoke other appropriate discipline against her license to practice Massage Therapy. subject only to the requirement that the Board shall, prior to such disciplinary action, conduct a hearing in accordance with Chapters 640C.622A and 233B of the Nevada Revised States for the limited purpose of establishing that there has, in fact, been a violation of the requirements of this Order. In the event that a violation of the requirements is alleged, Respondent agrees to surrender her license to the Executive Director, if they so request, and refrain from practicing as a Massage Therapist until entry of a final order of the Board or a court of competent jurisdiction, whichever last occurs, regarding a potential violation. Respondent agrees to waive her right to appeal the substantive legal basis of the disciplinary action. In the event an alleged violation of this Order is taken to hearing and the facts which constitute the violation are determined to be not proven, no disciplinary action shall be taken by the Board and the probationary licensure previously ordered by the Board shall again be operative and in full force and effect.

15. CONSEQUENCES OF OTHER MISCONDUCT

In the event other misconduct is reported to the Board, this Order may be used as evidence against the Respondent to establish a pattern of behavior and for the purpose of proving additional acts of misconduct.
