**COMPLAINT AND  
NOTICE OF HEARING**

The Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (Board), by and through its Executive Director, Sandra Anderson, hereby notifies Alexis J. Orlosky ("Respondent") of an administrative hearing, which is to be held pursuant to Chapters 233B, 622, 622A of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and 640C of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). The purpose of the hearing is to consider the allegations stated below and to determine if the Respondent should be subject to an administrative penalty as set forth in NRS 640C.710, if the stated allegations are proven at the hearing by the evidence presented.

Respondent is currently and at all times mentioned herein, licensed as a massage therapist in the State of Nevada and is therefore, subject to the jurisdiction of the Board and the provisions of NRS Chapter 640C.

IT IS HEREBY ALLEGED AND CHARGED AS FOLLOWS:

**ALLEGED FACTS**

1. On or about April 11, 2019, Respondent was arrested and incarcerated in Lexington, Missouri for three counts of possession of a controlled substance, one count of delivery of a controlled substance and one count of resisting/interfering with arrest for a felony.
2. On or about May 3, 2019, Respondent was charged in Lafayette County, Missouri for possession of a controlled substance (oxycodone hydrochloride), FELONY; possession of a controlled substance (amphetamine), FELONY; possession of a controlled substance (marijuana), FELONY; delivery of a controlled substance, FELONY; and one count of resisting arrest, FELONY.
3. On or about May 19, 2019, Respondent submitted an application for massage therapy, which was subsequently granted.

1 4. On or about September 9, 2020, Respondent pled GUILTY in Lafayette County, Missouri  
2 to one charge of delivery of a controlled substance, FELONY; one charge of possession of  
3 a controlled substance, FELONY; and one charge of resisting arrest, FELONY; and was  
4 sentenced to suspended prison terms and placed on five years of supervised probation.  
5 Thus, Respondent is currently on probation.

6 **VIOLATIONS OF LAW**

7 **COUNT ONE**

8 5. By being convicted of a crime involving controlled substances, Respondent violated the  
9 provision of NRS 640C.700(3). This is grounds for discipline pursuant to NRS  
10 640C.700(2).

11 **COUNT TWO**

12 6. By being convicted of a crime involving violence, Respondent violated the provision of  
13 NRS 640C.700(3). This is grounds for discipline pursuant to NRS 640C.700(2).

14 **COUNT THREE**

15 7. By failing to report to the Board the September 9, 2020 criminal felony convictions in the  
16 state of Missouri, Respondent violated NAC 640C.090(3). This is grounds for discipline  
17 pursuant to NRS 640C.700(2).

18 **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

19 WHEREFORE, Executive Director, Sandra Anderson, prays as follows:  
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21 8. That the Board conduct a hearing on this complaint as provided by statute, and after such  
22 hearing, that the Board impose upon Respondent the discipline permitted by NRS  
23 640C.710, which may include the following, (a) the imposition of an administrative fine of  
24 not more than \$5,000.00 per violation, (b) recovery of reasonable investigative fees and costs  
25 incurred, (c) recovery of attorney fees pursuant to NRS 622.400, (d) licensee be publicly  
26 reprimanded, (e) suspend, revoke or place conditions on the licensee's license, (f) place the  
27 licensee on probation, and/or (g) such other impositions as may be permitted by Nevada law.

1 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a disciplinary hearing has been set to consider this  
2 Administrative Complaint against the above-named Respondent in accordance with Chapters 233B,  
3 622, 622A and 640C of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

11 PURSUANT TO NRS 622A.320, Respondent may, but is not required to, file an answer to  
12 this Complaint with the Board.

13 PURSUANT TO NRS 622A.330, Respondent may seek limited discovery from the Board.

14 As the Respondents, you are specifically informed that you have the right to appear and be  
15 heard in your defense, either personally or through counsel of your choice. You have the right to  
16 respond and to present relevant evidence and argument on all issues involved. You have the right to  
17 call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, and cross-examine opposing witnesses on any matter  
18 relevant to the issues involved.

19 You have the right to request that the Board issue subpoenas to compel witnesses to testify  
20 and/or evidence to be offered on your behalf. In making this request, you may be required to  
21 demonstrate the relevancy of the witnesses' testimony and/or evidence.

22 The purpose of the hearing is to determine if the Respondent has violated the provisions of  
23 Chapter 640C of NRS and if the allegations contained herein are substantially proven by the evidence  
24 presented to further determine what administrative penalty is to be assessed against the Respondent,  
25 if any, pursuant to NRS 640C.710.

26 Should the Respondent fail to appear at the hearing, a decision may still be reached by the  
27 Board. As the Respondent, you are further advised that you may be charged with the attorney's fees  
28 and/or costs associated with the hearing pursuant to NRS 622.400.

Pursuant to NRS 233B.121(5), informal disposition of this case may be made by stipulation,  
agreed settlement, consent order, or default. Any attempt to negotiate this case should be made by

1 Pursuant to NRS 241.033(2)(b), the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy may, without  
2 further notice, take administrative action against your license and/or certificate to practice within the  
3 State of Nevada if the Board determines that such administrative action is warranted after considering  
4 your character, alleged misconduct, professional competence, or physical or mental health.
