Dear Ms. Shi:

On your last renewal you indicated that you perform outcall massage. To protect the public, we are now conducting sanitation inspections for all licensees that provide outcall massage.

We have made several attempts to contact you both by email and by phone to schedule your outcall inspection and we have not received a response. This letter will serve as your final notice. You now have 60 days to comply or you will receive a notice to appear before the Board. You need to call (775) 224-8653 to schedule your outcall inspection. If you no longer provide outcall services, or are no longer practicing massage, send an email to cbrunner@imt.nv.gov with your name, license number and current status (i.e. do not provide outcall/not practicing massage). Once we receive this information, we will update your file.

Per NRS 640C.700(8), the Board may initiate disciplinary action against a holder of a license, if the holder of the license: (8) Has failed to provide information requested by the Board within 60 days after receiving the request.
