On June 8, 2022, the complaint matter for Ms. Hong Lu was set for a formal hearing and the proceedings were all conducted by videoconference on that date. Ms. Lu's case was apparently called prior to her signing in online on the Agenda date. Given the calendar that day, Ms. Lu incorrectly guessed that her matter would probably be called in the afternoon. Apparently, as I am advised, the Board called the matter at a time before she had logged on to the Zoom call.

Given her absence at the time the case was called and her lack of representation, the Board proceeded with revocation proceedings which revoked her license for 10 years and imposed maximum fines totaling \$15,000. These maximum penalties were imposed against Ms. Lu by default, without any input from her or opportunity to explain the events alleged in the complaint.

I appreciate the Board's reluctance to consider motions of this type, however, it appears that my client did attempt to participate in the hearing on June 8, just not at the right time. By way of this letter, I am requesting the Board's cooperation to allow for the reconsideration of this matter and to allow for a new hearing on the allegations of the Board's complaint. My client has material and relevant evidence to present in her defense which addresses the concerns alleged against her in this matter.
