ORDER

WHEREAS on Wednesday, August 10, 2022, the administrative hearing held relative to the Complaint in the above-captioned matter dated and signed July 8, 2022 having come before the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (Board), and the Board being fully apprised in the premises, and good cause appearing,

I.

INTRODUCTION

- Board members present were Elisabeth Barnard, Chair; Dierdre Strunk, Vice-Chair, Rebecca Dorangricchia, Secretary/Treasurer; Bianca Smith; Lorna Benedict; John Teng; and Stephanie Tsanas. The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department ("LVMPD") Advisory Member, Sergeant Aaron Fink, was also present.
- Sophia G. Long, Senior Deputy Attorney General, was present and appeared as prosecutor for the Board. Colleen Platt, Esq. from Platt Law Group, was present and appeared as counsel for the Board.
- 3. Hongying Xu-Rode ("Respondent"), was present with counsel, Mitchell S. Bisson, Esq. from the Law Office of Mitchell S. Bisson, and Mandarin interpreter Jenny Lui.

II.

JURISDICTION

Respondent is currently and at all times mentioned herein, licensed as a massage therapist
in the State of Nevada and is therefore, subject to the jurisdiction of the Board and the
provisions of NRS Chapter 640C.

III.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 7. The Board, having considered all the evidence presented, the testimony of witnesses, and the arguments of counsel, for good cause appearing, finds sufficient quantity and/or quality of evidence sufficient to meet the preponderance of the evidence standard of proof as set forth by NRS 622A.370 and by Nassiri v. Chiropractic Physicians' Board of Nevada, 130 Nev. Adv. Op, 27, at 8-9 (April 3, 2014).
- 8. Via Complaint and Notice of Hearing dated July 8, 2022, Respondent was notified of the administrative hearing scheduled for Wednesday, August 10, 2022.
- 9. Detective Aliyev testified to the following:
 - a. That on January 28, 2022, he was working undercover investigating prostitution related crimes.
 - b. At approximately 8:05p.m., he entered Diva Foot Spa located at 6135 W. Sahara Ave., Suite #1, Las Vegas, Nevada 89146, and was greeted by Respondent; he subsequently paid forty dollars (\$40.00) for a half hour massage.
 - c. During the massage, Respondent touched his buttocks and testicles.
 - d. He asked for a "blowjob," wherein Respondent nodded and responded, "I want it in my mouth."

- e. He asked for sex wherein Respondent declined, but negotiated two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for a "blowjob" with a condom, or four hundred dollars (\$400.00) for a "blowjob" without a condom.
- f. He and Respondent agreed on a "blowjob" with a condom for two hundred dollars (\$200).
- g. He cited Respondent for soliciting/prostitution and completed a case report (Exhibit 1).

10. Hongying Xu-Rode, Respondent, testified to the following:

- a. She began work that day at 3:00p.m. and that she was the only employee the entire time.
- b. She worked for the massage establishment for three (3) days before the alleged facts in the Complaint.
- c. Earlier that day, she saw on the news a shooting that took place in an Asian massage establishment in New Mexico, which led to her being afraid that day.
- d. The doors are locked when there aren't any customers.
- e. When Detective Aliyev entered the establishment, she was afraid because he was a big man with what looked like a fake beard.
- f. That during the massage, Detective Aliyev relentlessly propositioned her for sexual activity, and she refused several times and became further afraid.
- g. She received a citation wherein she appeared in court and after completing certain requirements, the matter was dismissed (Exhibit 2).

11. The Board finds that:

- a. The facts in the complaint are true.
- b. Detective Aliyev's testimony is more credible than Respondent's testimony.
- c. The specific manner in which Respondent touched Detective Aliyev is indicative of solicitation and is known by detectives in determining whether soliciting activity is present.
- 12. Any of the Findings of Fact that are or can be construed as Conclusions of Law is hereby incorporated as such to the extent as if originally so designated.

IV.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 13. Having made the aforementioned findings, the Board decides that there is sufficient quantity and/or quality of evidence sufficient to meet the preponderance of the evidence standard of proof as set forth by NRS 622A.370 and by Nassiri v. Chiropractic Physicians' Board of Nevada, 130 Nev. Adv. Op, 27, at 8-9 (April 3, 2014) to make the following conclusions of law:
- 14. By soliciting sexual activity during the course of practicing a massage, Respondent violated the provisions of NRC 640C.700(4) and NRS 640C.700(9).
- 15. Any Conclusions of Law that are or can be construed as Findings of Fact is hereby incorporated as such to the extent as if originally so designated.

V.

ORDER

Having found by preponderance of the evidence the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law set forth herein and having unanimously voted, THE BOARD HEREBY ORDERS:

- 1. Pursuant to NRS 640C.710, Respondent's license is REVOKED for ten (10) years.
- 2. Respondent shall pay a fine of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for each count, totaling five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).
- Respondent shall reimburse the Board for administrative costs incurred in this matter, see attached.
