Fingerprint Background Walver

NOTICE OF NONCRIMINAL JUSTICE APPLICANT'S RIGHTS



c. Review Application of Kendal Priestly. (For Discussion and Possible Action)


Kendal Priestly was present.

ORDER FOR PROBATION

IT APPEARING on January 8, 2020, Kendal L. Priestly ("Priestly") appeared before the Nevada Board of Massage Therapy ("Board") for an application review.

The Board granted Priestly a license to practice massage therapy and immediately placed Priestly's license on probation for a period of two (2) years.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Priestly will attend probation orientation.
- 2. Priestly shall submit to a background check within one year of the date of this Order and within two years of the date of this Order at Priestly's expense.
- 3. Priestly must refrain from providing outcall services.
- 4. Priestly must report all contact with law enforcement personnel within forty-eight (48) hours after such contact occurs.
- 5. Priestly must notify the Board of any changes in her employment within 15 days.
- 6. Priestly must provide any changes in address or phone number to the Board office within 15 days.
- 7. Priestly is to submit to random drug test at Priestly's expense.
- 8. Priestly must cooperate fully with the Board staff to administrate terms of her probation.
- 9. This order shall not be construed as excluding or reducing any criminal or civil penalties of sanction or other remedies that may be applicable under federal, state or local laws.
- 10. Priestly's license shall be marked "Restricted" throughout the probationary period.
- 11. Priestly shall meet with the Board or its representatives upon request and shall cooperate with representatives of the Board in her supervision and investigation of Priestly's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Order.



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- 12. This Order will become part of Priestly's permanent record, will become public information, will be published with the list of disciplinary actions the Board has taken, and may be reported to any national repository which records disciplinary action taken against licensees or holders of certificates or any agency or another state, which regulates the practice of massage therapy. The Board may use the Order in any subsequent hearings.
- 13. Priestly acknowledges that if she violates one or more of the terms of this Order, the Board may revoke or invoke other appropriate discipline against her license to practice massage therapy; subject only to the requirement that the Board shall, prior to such disciplinary action, conduct a hearing in accordance with Chapters 233B, 622A, and 640C of the Nevada Revised Statutes for the limited purpose of establishing that there has, in fact, been a violation of the requirements of this Order. In the event that a violation of this Order is alleged, Priestly agrees to surrender her license to the Executive Director, if so requested, and refrain from practicing as a massage therapist until an entry of a final order of the Board or a court of competent jurisdiction, whichever last occurs, regarding the potential violation. Priestly agrees to waive her right to appeal the substantive legal basis of the disciplinary action. In the event an alleged violation of this Order is taken to hearing and the facts which constitute the violation are determined to be not proven, no disciplinary action shall be taken by the Board.
- 14. In the event other misconduct is reported to the Board, this Order may be used as evidence against Priestly to establish a pattern of behavior and for the purpose of proving additional acts of misconduct.
- 15. Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy retains jurisdiction in this case until all conditions have been met to the satisfaction of the Board.





Kendal Priestly was present. Teresa Lopez recused based on her relationship with the licensee stating that Ms. Priestly had been one of her students.



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COMPLAINT AND NOTICE OF HEARING

Case No. NVMT-S-2041

The Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (Board), by and through its Executive Director, Sandra Anderson, hereby notifies Kendal L. Priestly ("Respondent") of an administrative hearing, which is to be held pursuant to Chapters 233B, 622, 622A of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and 640C of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). The purpose of the hearing is to consider the allegations stated below and to determine if the Respondent should be subject to an administrative penalty as set forth in NRS 640C.710, if the stated allegations are proven at the hearing by the evidence presented.

Respondent is currently and at all times mentioned herein, licensed as a massage therapist in the State of Nevada and is therefore, subject to the jurisdiction of the Board and the provisions of NRS Chapter 640C.

IT IS HEREBY ALLEGED AND CHARGED AS FOLLOWS:

ALLEGED FACTS

- 1. On or about January 8, 2020, Respondent's application to practice massage therapy was reviewed before the Board at a properly noticed board meeting. Respondent was granted a license to practice massage therapy with the condition of being placed on probation for two (2) years.
- 2. On or about January 21, 2020, the Board issued the Order of Probation which included the following conditions, among other conditions:
 - a. Attend probation orientation;
 - b. Submit to a background check within one year of the date of the Order and within two years of the date of the Order at Respondent's expense;

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- c. Refrain from providing outcall services¹;
- d. Report all contact with law enforcement personnel within forty-eight (48) hours after such contact occurs;
- e. Notify the Board of any changes of employment within 15 days;
- f. Provide any changes in address or phone numbers to the Board office within 15 days; and,
- g. Submit to random drug tests at Respondent's expense.
- On or about September 12, 2020, Respondent submitted to a random drug test that resulted in positive analysis for AMPHETAMINE, METHAMPHETAMINE, and MARIJUANA METABOLITES.

VIOLATIONS OF LAW

COUNT ONE

4. By testing positive for AMPHETAMINE, METHAMPHETAMINE, and MARIJUANA METABOLITES from her drug test, Respondent violated the provisions of NRS 640C.700(13) and/or (9). This is grounds for discipline pursuant to NRS 640C.700(2).

COUNT TWO

5. By testing positive for AMPHETAMINE, METHAMPHETAMINE, and MARIJUANA METABOLITES from her drug test, Respondent violated the provisions of NRS 640C.700(5) and/or (9). This is grounds for discipline pursuant to NRS 640C.700(2).

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Executive Director, Sandra Anderson, prays as follows:

6. That the Board conduct a hearing on this complaint as provided by statute, and after such hearing, that the Board impose upon Respondent the discipline permitted by NRS 640C.710, which may include the following, (a) the imposition of an administrative fine of not more than \$5,000.00 per violation, (b) recovery of reasonable investigative fees and costs incurred, (c) recovery of attorney fees pursuant to NRS 622.400, (d) licensee be publicly reprimanded, (e) suspend, revoke or place conditions on the licensee's license, (f) place the licensee on

probation, and/or (g) such other impositions as may be permitted by Nevada law.



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WHEREAS on Wednesday, November 4, 2020, the administrative hearing held relative to the Complaint in the above-captioned matter dated and signed October 3, 2020 having come before the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (Board), and the Board being fully apprised in the premises, and good cause appearing,

I.

INTRODUCTION

- Board members present were Diane Huelva, Chair; Deirdre Strunk, Vice-Chair; Elisabeth Barnard, Secretary/Treasurer; Bianca Smith; Lorna Benedict; Bob Oliver; Richard Fields; and Sommer Plotnick. The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department Advisory Member, Detective James Downing, was also present.
- Sophia G. Long, Senior Deputy Attorney General, was present and appeared as prosecutor for the Board. Justin Taruc, Deputy Attorney General, was present and appeared as counsel for the Board.
- 3. Kendal L. Priestly ("Respondent"), was present.

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JURISDICTION

5. Respondent is currently and at all times mentioned herein, licensed as a massage therapist in the State of Nevada and is therefore, subject to the jurisdiction of the Board and the provisions of NRS Chapter 640C.

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FINDINGS OF FACT

- 6. The Board, having considered all the evidence presented, the testimony of witnesses, and the arguments of counsel, for good cause appearing, finds sufficient quantity and/or quality of evidence sufficient to meet the preponderance of the evidence standard of proof as set forth by NRS 622A.370 and by Nassiri v. Chiropractic Physicians' Board of Nevada, 130 Nev. Adv. Op, 27, at 8-9 (April 3, 2014).
- 7. Via Complaint and Notice of Hearing dated October 3, 2020, Respondent was notified of the administrative hearing scheduled for November 4, 2020.
- 8. Senior Deputy Attorney General, Sophia G. Long provided the following:
 - a. Ms. Priestly was placed on probation at the time the Board issued her a license on January 8, 2020, wherein one of the probation terms was that she submit to random drug tests at her own expense; and one of the restrictions placed on her probationary license was no outcall services.
 - b. Ms. Priestly petitioned the Board at the August 19, 2020 Board meeting to lift the restriction for outcall services as she planned to operate her own business. The Board lifted this restriction.
 - c. Ms. Priestly's September 2020 drug test returned positive for amphetamine, methamphetamine and marijuana.
 - d. The exhibits were provided to the Board.

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- 9. Ms. Priestly testified to the following:
 - a. That she admitted to the positive drug test and probation violation.
 - b. That she has been 30 days clean and is in counseling, AA, and in an intensive outpatient program.
 - c. That she took a leave of absence from Massage Envy.
 - d. That the last day she used drugs was October 1, 2020.
- 10. Any of the Findings of Fact that are or can be construed as Conclusions of Law is hereby incorporated as such to the extent as if originally so designated.

IV.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 11. Having made the aforementioned findings, the Board decides that there is sufficient quantity and/or quality of evidence sufficient to meet the preponderance of the evidence standard of proof as set forth by NRS 622A.370 and by Nassiri v. Chiropractic Physicians' Board of Nevada, 130 Nev. Adv. Op, 27, at 8-9 (April 3, 2014) to make the following conclusions of law:
- 12. By testing positive for AMPHETAMINE, METHAMPHETAMINE, and MARIJUANA METABOLITES from her drug test, Respondent violated the provisions of NR 640C. 700(5) and (9).
- 13. By testing positive for AMPHETAMINE, METHAMPHETAMINE, and MARIJUANA METABOLITES from her drug test, Respondent violated the provisions of NR 640C. 700(13) and (9).
- 14. Any Conclusions of Law that are or can be construed as Findings of Fact is hereby incorporated as such to the extent as if originally so designated.

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ORDER

Having found by preponderance of the evidence the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law set forth herein and having unanimously voted, THE BOARD HEREBY ORDERS:

1. Pursuant to NRS 640C.710, Respondent's license is REVOKED for One year.
