In September of 2020, Ms. Priestly failed a random drug test, resulting in a violation of her probation terms. During a probation hearing on November 4, 2020, Ms. Priestly was found guilty of the violations and was revoked for a term of one year. Ms. Priestly is requesting to be granted a reinstatement license under NRS 640C.580 and is before you today for review under NRS 640C.700.







Kendal Priestly was present. Teresa Lopez recused based on her relationship with the licensee stating that Ms. Priestly had been one of her students.



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
