Per NRS 640C.700(8), the Board may initiate disciplinary action against a holder of a license, if the holder of the license: (8) Has failed to provide information requested by the Board within 60 days after receiving the request. Per NRS 640C.710 disciplinary action may include, but is not limited to, fines, fees, and a public reprimand.
