**COMPLAINT AND  
NOTICE OF HEARING**

The Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (Board), by and through its Executive Director, Sandra Anderson, hereby notifies Shubo Lin-Washmon ("Respondent") of an administrative hearing, which is to be held pursuant to Chapters 233B, 622, 622A of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and 640C of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). The purpose of the hearing is to consider the allegations stated below and to determine if the Respondent should be subject to an administrative penalty as set forth in NRS 640C.710, if the stated allegations are proven at the hearing by the evidence presented.

Respondent is currently and at all times mentioned herein, licensed as a massage therapist in the State of Nevada and is therefore, subject to the jurisdiction of the Board and the provisions of NRS Chapter 640C.

IT IS HEREBY ALLEGED AND CHARGED AS FOLLOWS:

**ALLEGED FACTS**

1. Respondent, is and at all times herein, owner of Spa One located at 5435 S. Fort Apache Rd., Suite 104, Las Vegas, Nevada 89048 ("Establishment").
2. On or about January 22, 2020, Chaoxia Fan, was arrested for soliciting sexual activity on an undercover police officer during the course of practicing massage.
3. On or about July 22, 2020, Chaoxia Fan, was arrested for soliciting sexual activity on an undercover police officer during the course of practicing massage.
4. On or about October 26, 2021, Chaoxia Fan, while working at Establishment, was arrested for soliciting sexual activity on an undercover police officer during the course of practicing massage
5. Chaoxia Fan was not and is not currently licensed with the Board.

1 THE HEARING WILL TAKE PLACE on **Wednesday, March 30, 2022, commencing at**  
2 **9:00 a.m.** or as soon thereafter as the Board is able to hear the matter with video conferencing by  
3 Zoom.

9 PURSUANT TO NRS 622A.320, Respondent may, but is not required to, file an answer to  
10 this Complaint with the Board.

11 PURSUANT TO NRS 622A.330, Respondent may seek limited discovery from the Board.

12 As the Respondents, you are specifically informed that you have the right to appear and be  
13 heard in your defense, either personally or through counsel of your choice. You have the right to  
14 respond and to present relevant evidence and argument on all issues involved. You have the right to  
15 call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, and cross-examine opposing witnesses on any matter  
16 relevant to the issues involved.

17 You have the right to request that the Board issue subpoenas to compel witnesses to testify  
18 and/or evidence to be offered on your behalf. In making this request, you may be required to  
19 demonstrate the relevancy of the witnesses' testimony and/or evidence.

20 The purpose of the hearing is to determine if the Respondent has violated the provisions of  
21 Chapter 640C of NRS and if the allegations contained herein are substantially proven by the evidence  
22 presented to further determine what administrative penalty is to be assessed against the Respondent,  
23 if any, pursuant to NRS 640C.710.

24 Should the Respondent fail to appear at the hearing, a decision may still be reached by the  
25 Board. As the Respondent, you are further advised that you may be charged with the attorney's fees  
26 and/or costs associated with the hearing pursuant to NRS 622.400.

27 Pursuant to NRS 233B.121(5), informal disposition of this case may be made by stipulation,  
28 agreed settlement, consent order, or default. Any attempt to negotiate this case should be made by

Pursuant to NRS 241.033(2)(b), the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy may, without  
further notice, take administrative action against your license and/or certificate to practice within the

1 State of Nevada if the Board determines that such administrative action is warranted after considering  
2 your character, alleged misconduct, professional competence, or physical or mental health.
