**VOLUNTARY SURRENDER  
IN LIEU OF OTHER DISCIPLINE**

9 I, Astoria Shi, wish to voluntarily surrender my Nevada Massage Therapy License.

10 1. It is alleged that:

- 11 a. I am owner of Happy Asian Massage that advertises outcall massage services and  
12 prostitution activities online.  
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14 b. On or about August 10, 2021, I was arrested for living off the earnings of a prostitute,  
15 **felony**; facilitating sex trafficking, **felony**; and two charges of pandering, **felony**. I was  
16 arrested as a result of an arrest warrant previously issued.  
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18 c. On or about December 6, 2021, I pled guilty to pandering.  
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20 d. Based on the above, my Clark County business license was suspended.

21 2. I admit that these factual allegations constitutes grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to NRS  
22 640C.710 because the conduct violates NRS 640C.700(3) and (9).

23 3. I am aware of, understand, and have been advised of the effect of this Voluntary Surrender.

24 4. I have read this Voluntary Surrender and I fully understand and acknowledge its facts and terms.

25 5. I am aware that I have certain constitutional rights, including:

26 (a) I have the right to hire an attorney to represent me in this proceeding;

27 (b) I have the right to demand a hearing on the charges against me, and I can require the

28 Board's staff to prove the allegations;

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- 1 (c) I have the right to cross-examine the witnesses against me;
- 2 (d) I have the right to call witnesses to provide evidence on my own behalf;
- 3 (e) I have other rights accorded to me under the Nevada Revised Statutes
- 4 Chapters 233B, 622, 622A and 640C; and
- 5
- 6 (f) I have the right to obtain judicial review of the Board's decision.

7 6. I am aware of the foregoing rights in paragraph five (5), and I voluntarily, knowingly, and

8 intelligently waive these rights in return for the Board accepting my voluntary surrender of my

9 massage therapist license in lieu of other disciplinary action.

10 7. I understand this Voluntary Surrender is considered disciplinary action and as such will become

11 part of my permanent record.

12 8. I understand this Voluntary Surrender is considered public information.

13 9. I understand this Voluntary Surrender is considered disciplinary action and will be reported to

14 the national repository, which records disciplinary action taken against licensees, or any agency

15 or another state, which regulates the practice of Massage Therapy.

16 10. I understand this Voluntary Surrender may be used in any subsequent hearings by the Board as

17 evidence against me to establish a pattern of behavior and for the purpose of proving additional

18 acts of misconduct.

19 11. This Voluntary Surrender shall not be construed as excluding or reducing any criminal or civil

20 penalties or sanctions in any other matter.

21 12. I understand that this surrender is effective on the date it was accepted by the Board, which is

22 June 8, 2022.
