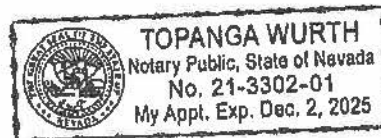


Dear Ms. Van Horn:

Please find enclosed a copy of the signed and notarized Affidavit of Applicant/ Authorization of Release and Termination of Probation paperwork as required for Ms. Kelly's request for early termination of her license probation.

We note that Ms. Kelly has answered negatively to question #2 on the Termination of Probation screening questions as Ms. Kelly, after consulting with legal counsel, reiterates that she has never been convicted of any offense and was never arrested. As discussed in detail with the Board prior to the issuance of Ms. Kelly's license, Ms. Kelly was issued a citation by mail several months after an investigation of her workplace in April 2017. The charge noted in the citation were ultimately dismissed. 

IT APPEARING on March 31, 2021, LIANYAN KELLY ("Kelly") appeared before the Nevada Board of Massage Therapy ("Board") for disciplinary action.

The Board placed Kelly's license on probation for a period of five (5) years.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Kelly will attend probation orientation.
2. Kelly shall submit to a background check within one year of the date of this Order, within two years of the date of this Order, within three years of the date of this Order, within four years of the date of this Order, and within five years of the date of this Order at Kelly's expense.
3. Kelly must report all encounters with law enforcement personnel within fourteen (14) business days after such contact occurs.
4. Kelly cannot provide outcall services.
5. Kelly must work for an employer.
6. Kelly cannot work at any location identified as having a history of arrests for prostitution.
7. Kelly shall provide to the Board quarterly reports from employer for the first two (2) years followed by every six (6) months for the remainder of the following five years that Kelly is licensed.
8. Kelly must cooperate fully with the Board staff to administrate terms of her probation.
9. Kelly is responsible for all administrative fees incurred by the Board as a result of her probation compliance.
10. Kelly is to comply with all laws governing massage therapy.

- 1 11. This order shall not be construed as excluding or reducing any criminal or civil penalties or
2 sanction or other remedies that may be applicable under federal, state or local laws.
- 3 12. Kelly's license shall be marked "Restricted" throughout the probationary period.
- 4 13. Kelly shall meet with the Board or its representatives upon request and shall cooperate
5 with representatives of the Board in her supervision and investigation of Kelly's
6 compliance with the terms and conditions of this Order.
- 7 14. This Order will become part of Kelly's permanent record, will become public information,
8 will be published with the list of disciplinary actions the Board has taken, and may be
9 reported to any national repository which records disciplinary action taken against
10 licensees or holders of certificates or any agency or another state, which regulates the
11 practice of massage therapy. The Board may use the Order in any subsequent hearings.
- 12 15. Kelly acknowledges that if she violates one or more of the terms of this Order, the Board
13 may revoke or invoke other appropriate discipline against her license to practice massage
14 therapy; subject only to the requirement that the Board shall, prior to such disciplinary
15 action, conduct a hearing in accordance with Chapters 233B, 622A, and 640C of the
16 Nevada Revised Statutes for the limited purpose of establishing that there has, in fact,
17 been a violation of the requirements of this Order. In the event that a violation of this
18 Order is alleged, Kelly agrees to surrender her license to the Executive Director, if so
19 requested, and refrain from practicing as a massage therapist until an entry of a final order
20 of the Board or a court of competent jurisdiction, whichever last occurs, regarding the
21 potential violation. Kelly agrees to waive her right to appeal the substantive legal basis of
22 the disciplinary action. In the event an alleged violation of this Order is taken to hearing
23 and the facts which constitute the violation are determined to be not proven, no
24 disciplinary action shall be taken by the Board.
- 25 16. In the event other misconduct is reported to the Board, this Order may be used as evidence
26 against Kelly to establish a pattern of behavior and for the purpose of proving additional
27 acts of misconduct.
- 28 17. Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy retains jurisdiction in this case until all conditions
have been met to the satisfaction of the Board.
