This is my appeal to the issuance of citation #22139.

I did not receive this citation until July 30th, which is why I am late in appealing.

I started teaching Yoga classes at 1031 Whitney Ranch Dr. (the address where this citation was sent). I do not own the business at this address, I just teach Yoga. To help promote these classes, the owner suggested that I start a Yelp page. So, a few weeks ago I created a Yelp page. Part of opening the Yelp page is choosing categories, I selected "Massage Therapy" because I passed the MBLEx for the state of Nevada back in 2021, and I naively assumed that it was fine.

Around the same time I created the Yelp page, I was also updating my personal website. The idea of offering massage therapy was fresh in my mind, so I created a webpage for it.

BUT, I HAVE NOT MASSAGED ANYONE IN NEVADA.

Both the Yelp page and my website were premature actions, with the naive assumption that because I passed the MBLEx I was good to go in the state of Nevada.

I realize now that I was wrong. I did not complete the proper steps in order to become officially licensed in the state of Nevada, and therefore should not have begun advertising at all.

But I promise you, I have not received any inquiries from either Yelp or my website about massage therapy, and have not performed any massage therapy in Nevada.

As soon as I received this citation, I took "massage" off of my Yelp page, and I took down the webpage on my website.

On July 31st, I went to the FSMTB website and had my MBLEx results transferred to the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy. I have attached a screenshot from the confirmation email they sent me.

Also attached is my certificate from the massage therapy school I attended in California.

I am praying that you will forgive my naive assumptions and accept this appeal. I'll take all the steps necessary to rectify this, because as a small business owner, paying this citation would really damage me.

And if I can get this appealed, I will absolutely apply to get my license in Nevada. I love it in Nevada and would like to eventually offer my services as a healer and a bodyworker.


