**VOLUNTARY LICENSE  
SURRENDER AND SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT RE DISCIPLINE**

I, Li Hui He, wish to voluntarily surrender my Nevada Massage Therapy License. I am licensed as a massage therapist, license number NVMT.10915, and was licensed at the time the conduct described herein occurred. As such, I am therefore subject to the jurisdiction of the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (the "Board").

1. I knowingly, voluntarily, and fully admit the following facts:
  - a. On or about September 15, 2023, I was an employee at Asian Massage Vegas Spa located at 120 E. Bruner Ave., #165, Las Vegas, Nevada 89183.
  - b. On or about that date, I offered and agreed to provide sexual activity to an undercover police officer, as defined by NAC 640C.400(1). (Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department Case Report No.: LLV230900052169).
  - c. I was cited by Las Vegas Metropolitan Police for soliciting prostitution to an undercover police officer during the course of practicing massage. (Las Vegas Justice Court No.: 23-CR-083204).
2. I admit to the above factual allegations and that the Board could prove such factual allegations are true by a preponderance of the evidence.
3. I understand that these facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to NRS 640C.710 because the conduct violated NRS 640C.700(2), (4), and/or (9).
4. I am aware of, understand, and have been advised of the effect of this Voluntary Surrender.
5. I have read this Voluntary Surrender and I fully understand and acknowledge its facts and terms.

- 1 6. I am aware that I have certain constitutional rights, including:
- 2 (a) I have the right to hire an attorney to represent me in this proceeding;
- 3 (b) I have the right to demand a hearing on the charges against me, and I can require
- 4 the Board's staff to prove the allegations;
- 5 (c) I have the right to cross-examine the witnesses against me;
- 6 (d) I have the right to call witnesses to provide evidence on my own behalf;
- 7 (e) I have other rights accorded to me under the Nevada Revised Statutes
- 8 Chapters 233B, 622, 622A and 640C; and
- 9 (f) I have the right to obtain judicial review of the Board's decision.
- 10 7. I am aware of the foregoing rights, and I voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waive these
- 11 rights in return for the Board accepting my voluntary surrender of my massage therapist license
- 12 in lieu of other disciplinary action.
- 13 8. I understand this Voluntary Surrender is considered disciplinary action and as such will
- 14 become part of my permanent record.
- 15 9. I understand this Voluntary Surrender is considered public information.
- 16 10. I understand this Voluntary Surrender is considered disciplinary action and will be reported to
- 17 the national repository, which records disciplinary action taken against licensees, or any
- 18 agency or another state, which regulates the practice of Massage Therapy.
- 19 11. I am aware and understand that this Voluntary Surrender will be considered in any future
- 20 applications or petitions that I may submit to the Board, and that this Voluntary Surrender may
- 21 serve as grounds for the denial of such an application or petition upon the Board's
- 22 consideration.
- 23 12. I understand this Voluntary Surrender may be used in any subsequent hearings by the Board
- 24 as evidence against me to establish a pattern of behavior and for the purpose of proving
- 25 additional acts of misconduct.
- 26 13. This Voluntary Surrender shall not be construed as excluding or reducing any criminal or civil
- 27 penalties or sanctions in any other matter.
- 28 14. I understand that this surrender is effective on the date it is accepted by the Board.

1 I, Li Hui He, by my signature affixed below, agree with the foregoing facts and representations  
2 and thus choose to voluntarily surrender my License to practice as a massage therapist in Nevada.

3 NEVADA STATE BOARD OF MASSAGE THERAPY retains jurisdiction in this case until  
4 all conditions have been met to the satisfaction of the Board.
