**COMPLAINT AND
NOTICE OF HEARING**

The Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (Board), by and through its Executive Director, Elisabeth Barnard, hereby notifies YUEMING HUANG ("Respondent") of an administrative hearing, which is to be held pursuant to Chapters 233B, 241, 622, and 622A of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and 640C of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). The purpose of the hearing is to consider the allegations stated below and to determine if the Respondent should be subject to an administrative penalty as set forth in NRS 640C.710, if the stated allegations are proven at the hearing by the evidence presented.

Respondent is currently and at all times mentioned herein, licensed as a massage therapist in the State of Nevada and is therefore, subject to the jurisdiction of the Board and the provisions of NRS Chapter 640C.

IT IS HEREBY ALLEGED AND CHARGED AS FOLLOWS:

ALLEGED FACTS

1. On or about June 25, 2025 Massage Therapist YU FENG CHEN (hereinafter "CHEN"), while employed with Golden Thai Spa located at 2251 S. Rainbow Blvd., Las Vegas, NV 89146, which is owned and operated by RESPONDENT, CHEN was cited for engaging in/soliciting prostitution. (Case Report No. LLV250600094333).

2. Specifically, on that day, it is alleged that an undercover Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Detective (hereinafter "UC") entered into Golden Thai Spa on that date and asked CHEN for a 30-minute massage.

1 3. It is further alleged that, after having rendered the massage, CHEN agreed to perform
2 manual masturbation on the UC for a fee of \$100.

3 4. As a result, CHEN was cited for unlawfully engaging/soliciting prostitution.

4 5. On that same day, RESPONDENT was served with a Notice, also known as an
5 "Abatement Letter" (attached as Exhibit "A"), from Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Special
6 Investigator M. Gunn which informed RESPONDENT, as owner and operator of Golden Thai Spa, of
7 CHEN's solicitation of prostitution within her spa. This Notice was documented as having been served
8 on RESPONDENT dated June 25, 2025.

9 6. RESPONDENT, despite being aware of CHEN's soliciting prostitution within her spa,
10 and despite having an affirmative obligation to report such unethical and unprofessional conduct to
11 the Board within no more than thirty (30) days, failed to do so in violation of NRS 640C.700(10).

12 13 **VIOLATIONS OF LAW**

14 **COUNT ONE**

15 7. Knowingly failing to report to the Board that the holder of a license has engaged in
16 unethical or unprofessional conduct as it relates to the practice of massage therapy within 30 days of
17 becoming aware of the conduct in violation of NRS 640C.700(10).

18 19 **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

20 WHEREFORE, Executive Director, Elisabeth Barnard, prays as follows:

21 1. That the Board conduct a hearing on this complaint as provided by statute, and after
22 such hearing, that the Board impose upon Respondent the discipline permitted by NRS 640C.710, which
23 may include the following, (a) the imposition of an administrative fine of not more than \$5,000.00 per
24 violation, (b) recovery of reasonable investigative fees and costs incurred, (c) recovery of attorney fees
25 pursuant to NRS 622.400, (d) licensee be publicly reprimanded, (e) suspend, revoke or place conditions
26 on the licensee's license, (f) place the licensee on probation, and/or (g) such other impositions as may be
27 permitted by Nevada law.

1 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a disciplinary hearing has been set to consider this
2 Administrative Complaint against the above-named Respondent in accordance with Chapters 233B,
3 622, 622A and 640C of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

4 THE HEARING WILL TAKE PLACE on **October 22, 2025, commencing at 9:00 a.m.** or as
5 soon thereafter, at 1755 E Plumb Ln., Suite 254, Reno, NV 89502. The hearing may also be attended
6 virtually via Zoom. The Zoom information is as follows:

10 PURSUANT TO NRS 622A.320, Respondent may, but is not required to, file an answer to
11 this Complaint with the Board.

12 PURSUANT TO NRS 622A.330, Respondent may seek limited discovery from the Board.

13 As the Respondents, you are specifically informed that you have the right to appear and be
14 heard in your defense, either personally or through counsel of your choice. You have the right to
15 respond and to present relevant evidence and argument on all issues involved. You have the right to
16 call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, and cross-examine opposing witnesses on any matter
17 relevant to the issues involved.

18 You have the right to request that the Board issue subpoenas to compel witnesses to testify
19 and/or evidence to be offered on your behalf. In making this request, you may be required to
20 demonstrate the relevancy of the witnesses' testimony and/or evidence.

21 The purpose of the hearing is to determine if the Respondent has violated the provisions of
22 Chapter 640C of NRS and if the allegations contained herein are substantially proven by the evidence
23 presented to further determine what administrative penalty is to be assessed against the Respondent,
24 if any, pursuant to NRS 640C.710.

25 If you require the services of an interpreter, one will be provided for you at no charge. Please
26 notify our office by calling (775) 687-9955 or emailing nvmassgebd@lmt.nv.gov by Wednesday,
27 October 15, 2025, of your request.

1 Should the Respondent fail to appear at the hearing, a decision may still be reached by the
2 Board. As the Respondent, you are further advised that you may be charged with the attorney's fees
3 and/or costs associated with the hearing pursuant to NRS 622.400.

4 Pursuant to NRS 233B.121(5), informal disposition of this case may be made by stipulation,
5 agreed settlement, consent order, or default. Any attempt to negotiate this case should be made by
6 contacting **Senior Deputy Attorney General Todd M. Weiss Esq. at 702-486-3103**

7 Pursuant to NRS 241.033(2)(b), the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy may, without
8 further notice, take administrative action against your license and/or certificate to practice within the
9 State of Nevada if the Board determines that such administrative action is warranted after considering
10 your character, alleged misconduct, professional competence, or physical or mental health.

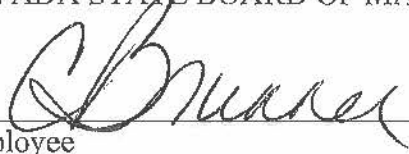
