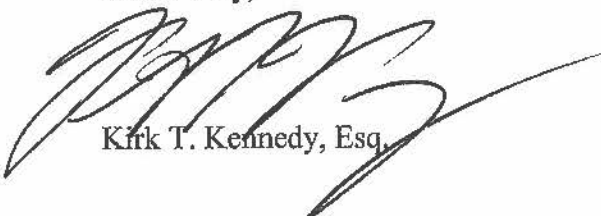
Dear Director Barnard:

Please accept this letter as a motion for reconsideration and/or rehearing of the Agenda matter from August 12, 2025, regarding Ms. Silu Liu. On August 12, there was a Complaint matter set for hearing for Ms. Liu, however, she did not appear and did not have any representative at the time. In her absence, the Board moved forward with a revocation of her license by default and imposed fines totaling \$20,000. My client was unaware of the necessity to appear and defend the Complaint matter.

Ms. Liu contacted my office and advised that she had no understanding about the Complaint process and due to language difficulties, she was unaware that she had an obligation to appear on August 12. On behalf of my client, I am requesting the Board's consideration to allow a rehearing of this matter on the next Agenda in October. Ms. Liu's lack of understanding regarding the Complaint process and the requirements to attend the designated hearing all contributed to her non-appearance. Given the severity of the Board's action, my client would request an opportunity to actually defend the matter with Counsel.

Kindly advise if the Board will allow a rehearing of the matter. I believe this is Ms. Liu's first disciplinary matter and she does desire to either contest the Complaint or attempt a possible resolution of the case. Thank you.

**FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND
ORDER**

WHEREAS on August 12, 2025, the administrative hearing held relative to the Complaint in the above-captioned matter having come before Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy ("Board"), and the Board being fully apprised in the premises, and good cause appearing, the Board issued the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. Board members present were Rebecca Dorangricchia, Chair, Paula Wilber, Vice Chair, Secretary-Treasurer Jenn Ty, Rosemarie Mueller, Bill Schoen, John Teng, and Sgt. Evan Fincher, LVMPD Advisory Member.

2. Todd Weiss, Deputy Attorney General, was present and appeared as the prosecutor for the Board. Board General Counsel Colleen Platt was present and served as Board counsel.

3. SILU LIU ("Respondent") did not appear at the disciplinary hearing but was duly notified by certified mail in compliance with NRS 241.0333.

II. JURISDICTION

4. RESPONDENT is licensed by the Board as a massage therapist, pursuant

1 to the provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes and Nevada Administrative Code chapters
2 640C, license no. 12234.

3 5. RESPONDENT is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board and the provisions
4 of NRS Chapter 640C and NAC Chapter 640C.

6 **III. FINDINGS OF FACT**

7 6. On or about March 12, 2025, Respondent, while employed with Wonderful
8 Spa located at 4110 S. Maryland Parkway, Las Vegas, NV 89119, you were cited for
9 engaging in/soliciting prostitution. (Case Report No. LLV250300044127).
10

11 7. Specifically, on that day, an undercover Las Vegas Metropolitan Police
12 Detective (hereinafter "UC") entered into Wonderful Spa and asked for a 30-minute
13 massage.
14

15 8. During said massage, you were not wearing clothing appropriate for a
16 massage therapist.
17

18 9. During said massage, you removed all draping/covering from the nude UC
19 and massaged his inner thigh area.
20

21 10. While performing the massage, you solicited the UC for a sex act in exchange
22 for money. Specifically, without being solicited, and through a combination of verbal
23 responses and non-verbal gestures, you agreed to perform manual sex and have sexual
24 intercourse with the UC in exchange for \$100 and \$200, respectively.
25

26 11. As a result of the foregoing, you were cited for engaging in unlawful
27 prostitution.
28

12. It was further discovered during a police search of the business that you had
been residing within the business and had personal belongings there within apparent
living quarters. You also voluntarily admitted to living within the business. As such, you
were also charged with living in or about a brothel/house of prostitution.

13. As a result of the foregoing events, you are currently facing multiple

1 criminal charges (Case No. 25-CR-023473).

3 **IV. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

4 14. Respondent, as evidenced by her actions as described above, is found by a
5 preponderance of evidence to have violated multiple provisions of NRS 640C and NAC
6 640C. As such, she is in violation of NRS 640C.700(2).

7 15. Respondent, as evidenced by her actions as described above, is found by a
8 preponderance of evidence to have solicited sexual intercourse as defined as "sexual
9 activity" under NAC 640C.400. As such, Respondent violated NRS 640C.700(4) by
10 engaging in and/or soliciting sexual activity during the course of practicing massage.

11 16. Respondent, as evidenced by her actions as described above, is found by a
12 preponderance of evidence to have failed to abide by Nevada statutes and regulations
13 relating to the practice of massage therapy, which constitutes "Unethical or
14 unprofessional conduct" under NAC 640C.410(1)(b)(17). As such, Respondent has
15 violated NRS 640C.700(9).

16 17. Respondent, as evidenced by her actions as described above, is found by a
17 preponderance of evidence to have engaged in and/or solicited sexual activity with the
18 UC, which constitutes "Unethical or unprofessional conduct" under NAC
19 640C.410(1)(b)(13) and (18). As such, Respondent has violated NRS 640C.700(9).

20
21 **V. ORDER**

22 18. Having found by a preponderance of the evidence the Findings of Fact and
23 Conclusion of Law set forth herein and having unanimously voted, THE BOARD
24 HEREBY ORDERS:

25 19. Respondent's Board license, NVMT.12234, is hereby **revoked** and
26 Respondent is ineligible to apply for new licensure for a minimum of five (5) years from
27 the date of this Order.

20. Respondent shall pay administrative fines in the amount of \$5,000 for each violation, for a total administrative fine of \$20,000 to be paid within five (5) years from the date of this Order.

21. Respondent shall partially reimburse the Board for investigation and prosecution costs in this matter, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000. This amount shall be paid within five (5) years from the date of this Order.

22. Failure of Respondent to pay the above ordered fines and cost reimbursement within the specified time period could result in Respondent being issued an Order to Appear and Show Cause from the Board who may then impose additional discipline on Respondent after hearing on the matter.
