



MASSAGE ESTABLISHMENT Sanitization Guidelines

Required Supplies:



- Soap in a covered dispenser
- Single use or disposable towels
- Waste receptacle
- Hot/Cold water
- EPA-approved disinfectant

Recommended Supplies:



- Disinfectant spray and/or wipes
- Hand sanitizer (at least 60% alcohol content)
- Disposable gloves
- Face masks
- Protective eye wear
- Face shields

Must Sanitize Between Each Client:

- Therapists hands
- All massage equipment
- All furniture
- All fixtures & massage tables
- All electrical equipment used for the care of a client
- All hydrotherapy equipment
- All surfaces touched by a client i.e. doorknobs, lightswitches, chairs, clothing racks, lockers and other fixtures
- Lubricant container
- Cash registers, credit/debit card systems
- Writing instruments and intake clipboards



Other Areas to Disinfect at Least Daily:

- Phones and tablets
- Towel warmer
- Dispensary cabinet and sink
- Restroom fixtures/hand washing station
- Stocked retail items
- Treatment room cabinetry and decor
- Remotes (candles, lighting, music)
- Mini fridge
- Reception area furniture, desk, computer and decorations



Single Use Items:

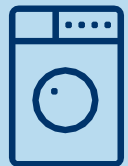
To be thrown away after one use



- Table paper
- Disposable face cradle covers
- Gloves
- Hair Ties/barrettes/scrunchies

Items To Be Laundered After Each Use:

Launder on hot or sanitize setting. Dry on hot or sanitize.



- Bolster covers
- Gowns
- Face rest covers
- Towels and linens
- Blankets or top covering

Facilities Not To Be Used:

- Vapor Baths
- Saunas
- Steam Rooms
- Portable Saunas
- Spas (as defined in NAC 640C.200(4))
